

### VF monthly follow up

January – November 2023

### Summary

#### Travel to Finland and to the Nordics compared to pre-pandemic

- According to our Border survey (Matkailijamittari), the total number of trips to Finland by foreign visitors was 3.4 million during March-November 2023 and the total amount the visitors spent in Finland was 2,654M€. The median length of stay was 4 nights, and 72% of the visitors were travelling for leisure.
- Number of <u>registered</u> foreign overnights during January-November 2023 were 21% below the 2019 level. If we leave the Russian travellers out of scope, the overnights were 11% behind 2019 figures.
  - Germany and Sweden are the biggest source markets for registered overnights.
  - From the main source markets, Germany, USA, France, the Netherlands, Italy, Belgium, and Austria have all exceeded the number of overnights they
    had before the pandemic (Jan-Nov 2019).
- As the **Eurostat statistics on short-term rental** data tables have now been published in Visit Finland Statistics Service Rudolf, we are now able to analyse the **total number of paid foreign overnights**.
  - In general, approximately every fifth paid foreign overnight is spent in a short-term rental accommodation.
  - Spanish and French travellers seemed to be the most active users of short-term rental in 2022.
  - Kymenlaakso and Kanta-Häme had the biggest share of short-term rental overnights by foreign visitors in 2022. Åland had clearly the smallest share.
- The latest recovery forecast by Oxford Economics is aligned with the current registered overnight statistics (Jan-Nov). Travel from Germany, USA, France, the Netherlands, Italy, Belgium, and Austria to Finland has recovered during 2023 to the pre-pandemic level.
  - Travel from Sweden, Spain, Switzerland, and India to Finland is forecasted to recover during this year
- International flight bookings to Finland for this winter (Nov-Feb) are currently 8% below the 2019 level.
- Flight connectivity to Finland is 19% below the pre-pandemic level during winter season.

### **Border Survey**

March-November 2023

- Leisure travel to Finland slowed down both in October and November
- Median length of stay on leisure trips was 4 nights in November as it was also in October
- Spending per leisure trip was 744€ in November, so it came down from October (979€), when the spending on leisure trip was at the highest level so far
- Share of package trips was 7% in November (highest in March, 15%)
- Leisure trips were booked 2.2 months before the trip in average in November (1.8 months before in October)

- August was clearly the busiest month with departing visitors
- After September, trips slowed down in October and November
- Median length of stay on leisure trips has been at the longest in July and August
- Swedes are leading by the number of leisure trips to Finland, followed by Estonians and Germans

### Spending in Finland / March-November 2023

#### Foreign visitors in Finland

- Total spend has been on the highest level for visitors whose trip in Finland ended in August as it was also the busiest month with visitors
- In July, the total spend was very high for business travellers because there were several visitors who had stayed in Finland for several months and were returning to their home country in July
- Spending per leisure trip was at the highest level in October (979€)
- Total spending on leisure trips has been highest for US visitors, followed by German and Swedish visitors

- **Carbon footprint** has been on the highest level in August so far, as is has also been the busiest travel month
- Carbon footprint per trip has been at the highest in March and November when the share of air travel was at the highest (75%)
- Total carbon footprint was clearly highest for US visitors, followed by German and British visitors

### **Overnights in short-term rentals**

We have now an easy access to the Eurostat statistics on overnights in short-term rentals (collaborative economy platforms, e.g. Airbnb), as the new data tables have been published in <u>Visit Finland Statistics Service</u> <u>Rudolf</u> by Statistics Finland.

Publishing schedule is slower than the one for registered overnight statistics, so that's why we also have now the statistics available only until June 2023.

The monthly statistics shows us the aggregate level (total – domestic – foreign) of overnights, while source country and destination specific statistics are published only on a yearly basis.

- In general, we can see that approximately **every fifth** paid foreign overnight is spent in **a short-term rental accommodation**.
- American and European travellers tend to use short-term rental more often than travellers from Asia.
- Among the biggest source markets during 2022, Spanish and French travellers seem to be the most active users of short-term rental, followed by Estonian, German, and US visitors.
- In **Kymenlaakso** and **South Karelia** the share of short-term rentals by foreign visitors was **around 40%** in 2022. Other regions where the share is **above one third** are **Southwest Finland**, **Kanta-Häme**, **South and North Savo**, and **Central Finland**.
- Short-term rentals have **clearly the smallest share** of foreign overnights in **Åland**.

# Oxford Economics forecast on travel recovery

Databank update in December 2023

- According to the forecast and also to the current overnight statistics (Jan-Nov) travel from Germany, USA, France, the Netherlands, Italy, Belgium, and Austria to Finland has recovered to the pre-pandemic level.
- Spending in Finland seems to be recovering at a faster pace than the overnights on each of our target markets.

### Flight arrivals & bookings

- Airline bookings for the winter months of Nov/23-Feb/24 show a significant increase from several source markets compared to 2019. Beside the EU countries, bookings show positive development from USA, Australia, India, Canada, and the UAE.
- On the other hand, total international air travel to Finland for Jun-Sep 2023 stayed nearly one third below the prepandemic level with only USA, the Netherlands, and Spain performing slightly better than in 2019.

### Seat capacity on int'l flights

- Seat capacity for the winter months of Nov/23-Feb/24 is 19% below the pre-pandemic level. However, there are clearly more direct flights from Europe to Lapland, so the seat capacity to Lapland has more than doubled.
- Seat capacity for Jun-Sep 2023 was 27% below the prepandemic level.
