Travel to Finland and to the Nordics compared to previous year and pre-pandemic

- The number of travellers to Finland from January to April 2025 has seen a modest rise compared to the same timeframe last year. Leisure travel grew by 7%, while business travel experienced a decline of 10%. Consequently, the total spend by leisure visitors was 11% greater than the previous year, whereas spending by business travellers fell by 20%.
- In terms of **registered foreign overnight stays**, there was an **11% increase** compared to the prior year, and this figure was also *3% higher than the levels recorded from January to April 2019*.
- Also, the **Nordic region** has experienced **10% growth** in **registered foreign overnight stays** from January to April 2025 compared to the same period last year.
- Flight bookings for the summer high season (Jun-Aug) show also positive development to Finland, Sweden, and Norway compared to the previous year. *However, only Norway exceeds the level in flight bookings of 2019*.

Border Survey

January-April 2025

- Trips and spend increased by 2% compared to January-April 2024.
 - This growth was driven by a higher demand for leisure travel, particularly for **vacation and recreational trips to Lapland**.
 - There was a decline in business travel compared to the previous year.
- The largest number of visitors originated from Estonia, Germany, the UK, France, and Sweden.
- Germany, France, the UK, Estonia, and the USA were the main contributors to the total spend in Finland.

Jan-Apr 2025 vs. Jan-Apr 2024

- With better air connectivity, there were more visitors arriving to Finland through the airports in Lapland. Thus, the main destination was more often also in Lapland than year before.
- More than half of the visitors travelled over 50 km within
 Finland. Car and train were the most used means of transport.

Jan-Apr 2025 vs. Jan-Apr 2024

- Total spend was highest for visitors coming from Germany and France and their total spend also increased clearly compared to the previous year.
- Destinations in Lapland were benefitting clearly from the higher total spend.
- Nearly 40% of the total spend was used for accommodation. The shares of shopping (incl. grocery) as well as restaurants and cafes were both around 20% of the total spend.

Registered Overnights

January – April 2025

- The number of registered foreign overnights reached 2.3 million, marking an 11% increase from the previous year. *This figure also surpassed the levels* of 2019 by 3%. The leading source markets were Germany, France, UK, and the Netherlands.
- Overall accommodation revenue grew by 4%, with foreign revenue rising by 18% compared to January-April 2024 (domestic revenue fell by 4%), and foreign revenue accounted for 43% of the total accommodation revenue.

<u>April 2025</u>

- Total foreign overnights reached **313,700** (+**14%** YoY, & -**12%** compared to April 2019).
- Leading source markets included Sweden, Germany, USA, UK, and Norway.
- Top destinations were **Helsinki**, Vantaa, Rovaniemi, Kittilä-Levi, and Turku.

Between January and April 2025, Germany and **France** emerged as the leading source markets in terms of **registered overnights**.

The number of overnights surpassed the previous year's totals from all main source markets, with the exception of Belgium.

In comparison to January-April 2019, overnights from Sweden (-8%), China including Hong Kong (-48%), Estonia (-24%), Japan (-14%), and Norway (-12%) continued to fall short of pre-pandemic figures.

Registered overnights in the Nordics

• Jan-Apr 2025

- There were **10.6 million** registered foreign overnight stays in the Nordics excluding Iceland (where currently the accommodation statistics are undergoing revisions). Overnights **increased by 10%** compared to the same period last year.
- Finland's market share among the four countries was 21%.
- Relative growth during Jan-Apr 2025 was strongest to Norway and Finland.

Flight bookings for Jun-Aug 2025

- Airline bookings to Finland for the summer months of June – August are increasing by 6% compared to last year. When comparing to summer 2019, the total int'l bookings are 14% below that level. However, among the main source markets USA, France, the Netherlands, Spain, and Poland show positive development compared to 2019.
- Bookings for the summer months to Norway continue to grow when comparing to both previous summer as well as to summer 2019. Bookings to Sweden are slightly increasing compared to previous summer, but clearly decreasing compared to summer pre-pandemic.

Seat capacity on int'l flights

June – August 2025

- Total int'l seat capacity for the summer months of June August is
 4% above 2024 level, but still -15% compared to the pre-pandemic level.
 - Seat capacity from Europe and Asia is improving compared to previous summer but remains below the level of summer 2019.
 - Seat capacity from USA is clearly above both summer 2024 and summer 2019 levels.
